Weave the Rings & Ropes Together

Page 69 - When attaching the rings to the ropes, I tell you to attach them both the same direction. Instead, the second ring should be attached the opposite way.

So for the first ring, you pull the ropes over the ring both times. For the second ring, you'll actually pull them **under** the rings. That will make them look like the photo above.

End Cap Attachment

Page 70 - The way I direct you to do it in the book isn't wrong...but this method may be a bit easier.

If you don't have thread that's still attached to the end cap, start a new thread there.

Then using the thread from the end cap, after inserting ends of the two ropes inside, stitch back and forth through the center of the end cap, making sure to stitch through the ropes inside to secure it.

I will stab through the end cap and ropes, stitch through a few beads on that side, then stab through again to the opposite side and repeat over and over until I feel like it's all secure.

End your thread.

Clasp Loop

Page 70 - In the book I tell you to use 34 beads in the loop. Instead, using 30 will make the loop more secure.
