

# **Pixie Dust Necklace**

## **Supply List**

- Size 11° seed beads 4 grams
- O beads 10-12 grams
- SuperDuo beads 7 grams
- 4mm Swarovski pearls 20-40
- Clasp of your choice
- Fireline 6lb
- Size 11 or 12 beading needles



This adorable necklace comes together quite quickly as necklaces go. You'll find yourself wearing it all the time! I do!

### Step 1

Using a comfortable length of Fireline, thread your needle and add a stopper bead.

## Step 2

Pick up:

- 1 SuperDuo
- 1 O bead
- 1 seed bead
- 1 O bead

Repeat picking up beads in that order until you have reached the length of necklace you desire.

## Length

The length you make will depend on how much extra space your clasp takes (while closed.) So measure your clasp and then subtract that from your desired finished necklace length. Example: I want an 18" necklace. My clasp will take up 1.5" of that. So the length of my beads section should be 16.5". https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wUvXljj3TSY&feature=player\_detailpage#t=401

## Step 3 - Attach the Clasp

End by adding a SuperDuo. While we're at this end, we'll attach one end of your clasp. Pick up a small loop of seed beads and pass through the hole in one end of your clasp. Pass back through the second hole in the SuperDuo you exited from, plus one segment of O beads and seed beads and one more SuperDuo. To reinforce the clasp, pass through this thread path two more times. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wUvXljj3TSY&feature=player\_detailpage#t=536

#### Step 4

Pick up:

- 1 O bead
- 1 seed bead
- 1 O bead

And then pass through the bottom hole in the next SuperDuo. Repeat two more times (a total of three.) https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wUvXIjj3TSY&feature=player\_detailpage#t=722

#### Step 5

This time, pick up:

- 1 O bead
- 1 pearl
- 1 O bead

And then pass through the bottom hole in the next SuperDuo.

Repeat steps 4 and 5 until you reach the end of your length and have passed through the last SuperDuo. Attach the second half of your clasp as you did before.

#### Add the Pearl Drops

Pass through the bottom row of beads until you are exiting the first pearl. Pick up:

- 1 seed bead
- 1 O-bead
- 1 seed bead
- 1 pearl
- 1 seed bead
- 1 O-bead
- 1 seed bead

And then pass back through the same pearl you were exiting on the bottom row (as if in a circle.) https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wUvXIjj3TSY&feature=player\_detailpage#t=856



Pass through the bottom row of beads until you're exiting the next pearl and repeat the embellishment. Continue until you reach the other end of the necklace.

If necessary, you can tighten up any loose spots in the necklace by passing through the beads again and pulling the thread tighter.

To add and end your thread, you can tie a few half-hitch knots to secure it.
